Role Purpose:

Inntravel's intranet system is a fundamental component in the delivery of tailored travel arrangements and holiday packages to customers as well as central to the delivery of the next generation of booking/reservation system applications (TISv2).

Working alongside the Head of IT and the IT Systems Support & Software Developer; the WD will maintain the existing portfolio of intranet applications and reporting systems, including enhancements to these applications to meet the growing/developing needs of the business. The WD will also be engaged in the future development of the new booking/reservation system which will migrate the functionality of the TIS application from SQLWindows/SQLBase to the intranet and SQL Server platform.

While the role is primarily dedicated to the maintenance and development of the intranet systems, the WD also plays a role within the operation of the wider IT Team providing user support to Inntravel's office-based staff, homeworkers, overseas consultants and other associates for a wide range of typical issues and it is expected that the WD will learn other aspects of the department's activities to provide this additional back-up support. This would include some knowledge of Inntravel's network, security and telecommunications systems.

Responsibilities & Tasks:

• Intranet Development

- Maintain the existing portfolio of intranet application;
- Liaise with other Inntravel staff to define requirements for new systems and/or enhancements to existing systems;
- Prepare development/enhancement proposals to be used to determine the priorities for the IT development programme.

• Future Development

 Assist the Head of IT and the IT Systems Support & Software Developer in the specification, design and development of the new booking/reservation system.

• Reporting Systems

 Provide assistance to the IT Systems Support & Software Developer in the maintenance of the various Inntravel reporting systems, and the on-going development and integrations of future reporting systems into Inntravel intranet platform.

User Support

- Provide user support to Inntravel's office-based staff, homeworkers, overseas consultants and other associates in resolving technical problems with Inntravel's IT systems;
- Provide training and coaching to Inntravel staff on the operation of IT equipment and Inntravel systems.

Other Tasks

- Be constantly mindful of the security of the internal and external systems Inntravel uses, and alert the Head of IT or IT Infrastructure Specialist should any failure or weakness be identified;
- Any other duty as required by management commensurate with the post.
